Fly To Alicante Airport

TRAIN Nearest train station to Javea – Denia

BUS ALIA buses run from Alicante to Javea regularly and the 2-hour trip costs €12.

TAXI Taxi costs €150 and takes an hour and 20 minutes.

SHUTTLE Beniconnect arranges shuttle buses and minibuses and if everyone arrives together we could arrange this for about €50 per trip per person.

CAR HIRE Car hire from airport is easy but there are some dodgy providers. We recommend Blancacars.com

WALKING DURING THE RETREAT
